<b>1770</b>	<b>Treaty of Lochabar</b>	<b>Lands north and east of a line running through Long Island on the Holston River. In 1771, the Cherokees agreed to include the area around the Holston.</b>	<b>Promise that white settlers would not be allowed to settle on the remaining Indian land</b>
<b>1775</b>	<b>Treaty of Sycamore Shoals</b>	<b>The Transylvania Land Company got ownership of north central TN</b>	<b>British trade goods</b>
<b>1785</b>	<b>Treaty of New Hopewell</b>	<b>Cherokee land south of the Cumberland River</b>	<b>Peace with the United States and protection of Indian land</b>
<b>1791</b>	<b>Treaty of Holston</b>	<b>Area east of the Clinch River and north of a line through Kingston</b>	<b>Release of prisoners, "certain valuable goods" plus \$1,000 a year</b>
<b>1798</b>	<b>First Treaty of Tellico</b>	<b>Lands between the Clinch River and the Cumberland Plateau and between the Tennessee and Little Tennessee rivers</b>	<b>Various payments and guarantee of right of the Cherokee Nation to "live forever."</b>
<b>1805</b>	<b>Third Treaty of Tellico</b>	<b>All land north of the Duck River all the way east to the Tennessee River (the Cumberland Plateau)</b>	<b>\$14,000, plus \$3,000 a year</b>
<b>1806</b>	<b>Treaty of Washington</b>	<b>Land south of the Duck River</b>	<b>Creeks got \$14,000, Cherokees received \$10,000, a gristmill, a cotton gin, and \$100 yearly</b>

<b>1817</b>	<b>Jackson and McMinn Treaty</b>	<b>Lands along the Sequatchie River</b>	<b>Land in Arkansas</b>
<b>1818</b>	<b>Jackson Purchase</b>	<b>Chickasaw land between the Mississippi River and the Tennessee River (West Tennessee)</b>	<b>\$300,000, to be paid over 20 years</b>
<b>1819</b>	<b>Calhoun Treaty (The Hiwassee Purchase)</b>	<b>Cherokee land between the Little Tennessee and the Hiwassee Rivers</b>	<b>Payment (for land that was actually already being settled)</b>
<b>1835</b>	<b>Treaty of New Echota</b>	<b>All remaining Cherokee land in TN</b>	<b>Land in Oklahoma</b>
